1. After logging in and selecting your course, click **Gradebook** in the left navigation menu (Figure 1).

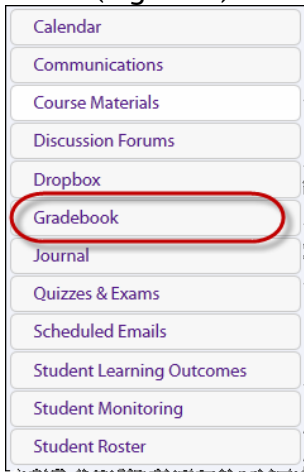

2. Click **Gradebook Statistics** (Figure 2).

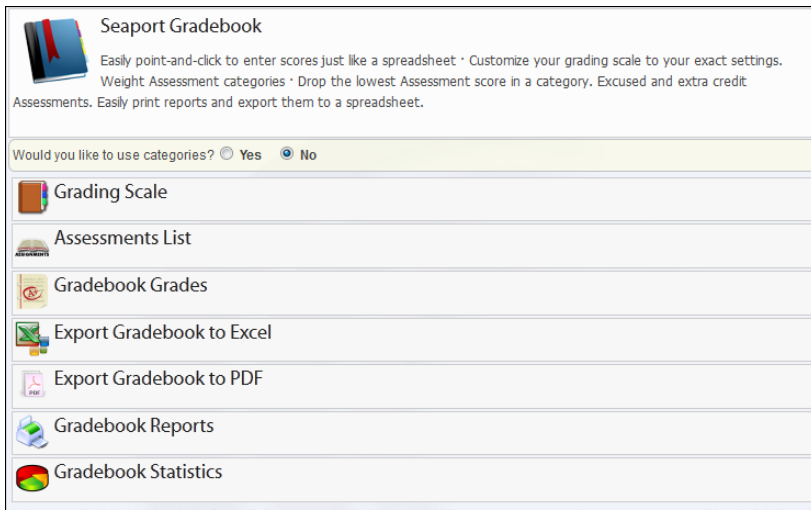



